2nd Day, Friday – Cruise.

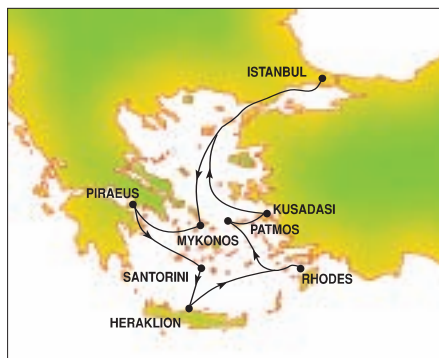
Ulysses people meet you at the airport, assist and escort you to Piraeus for boarding on your 7-day cruise. All meals included.
