

Motorcoach Organized Tours



The organized tours are complete tour packages that offer the best available hotels outside Athens. They are escorted by English speaking guides, on deluxe air-conditioned motorcoaches and include all entrance fees to places visited. Full day tours include lunch. Overnight tours include breakfast & dinner daily. Single occupancy suppl., \$66 per night.

HALF-DAY SELECTION

ATHENS SIGHTSEEING: Half day morning. Daily (except holidays). 9:15 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.

This tour includes an overview of the modern city. Drive to the tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Panathenian Stadium (site of the first modern Olympic Games in 1896). Visit the Temple of Olympian Zeus, and the crowning beauty, the Parthenon with its many monuments atop the Acropolis, including, the Temple of Athena Nike and the Erechtheion with its Porch of Maidens. We also visit the Acropolis Museum.

Rate per person: \$69.

ATHENS BY NIGHT: Daily, Apr. 01 to Oct. 31; Thursday & Saturday Nov. 01 to Mar. 31, 09 8:30 pm - Midnight.

Drive along the illuminated boulevards of Athens. Continue to Marina Zea, one of the busiest yacht harbors in the Mediterranean. We finally return to Athens and the renowned "Plaka" district for dinner with live floor shows at a typical Greek taverna. Note: Drinks with dinner are not included.

Rate per person: \$80.

SOUNION: Daily, Apr. 01 to Oct 31, 2008. 3:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Mon, Wed, Fri, Sat. Nov. 01-Mar 31, 2009. Driving along the coastal road past countless coves, we arrive at Sounion. A crowning feature is Cape Sounion, dominated by the spectacular Temple of Poseidon overlooking the Aegean Sea.

Rate per person: \$52.

ANCIENT CORINTH: Monday & Friday from Apr. 14 to Oct. 31. 8:15 am - 7:00 p.m.

Drive west from Athens to the spectacular Corinth Canal (brief stop). Continue to Ancient Corinth, view the archaic Greek Temple of Apollo, one of the oldest in Greece. Here in 52AD St. Paul appeared before the Roman governor Gallio and later wrote his famous letters to the Corinthian Christians. Before returning to Athens a brief stop at the ancient port of Kenchreai where St. Paul disembarked in 51AD and founded a Christian community.

Rate per person \$84.

ONE-DAY SELECTION

ARGOLIS - MYCENAE - NAUPLIA - EPIDAUROS Tues, Wed, Thur & Sat. from Apr. 03 to Oct. 31 Tues, & Sat. from Nov. to Mar. 2009

8:15 a.m. - 6:30 p.m.

Drive along the coastal road of the Saronic Gulf to the Corinth Canal (brief stop). Proceed to Mycenae, visit the Tombs of Agamemnon and the Palace. Then on to Nauplia. After lunch, visit Epidaurus and its theatre, famous for its remarkable acoustics.

Rate per person \$123.

DELPHI: Daily, Apr. to Oct. Wed, Fri & Sun. Nov. to Mar. 2009 8:15 a.m. - 6:30 p.m.

Drive through Levadia and Arachova. Arrive in Delphi, the ancient sanctuary of Apollo. Visit the Museum in which one can see among other archaeological treasures, the unique bronze Charioteer. Visit the Temple of Apollo, the Castalia Spring, etc.

Rate per person: \$123.

ONE DAY THREE-ISLE CRUISE: Full day. Daily, All year Round.

Set sail for the island of Hydra. You have time at for strolling, shopping or swimming. Sail for the island of Aegina, Lunch is served after sailing. Short visit of Poros. Finally, re-embark for the sail back to Flisvos Marina. **Rate per person: \$140.**

TWO-DAY SELECTION

ARGOLIS - MYCENAE - NAUPLIA - EPIDAUROS Tues and Wed from Apr. to Oct. 08

8:30 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. (2nd day)

1st day: Corinth Canal - Mycenae (visit) - Nauplia (lunch). Afternoon at leisure. Overnight.

2nd day: Nauplia, morning at leisure. Epidaurus (visit). Athens. (Participants on this tour will have an afternoon and morning at leisure for swimming or strolling through the streets of Nauplia).

Rate per person: \$221.

DELPHI

Daily service from Apr. to Oct. 08

8:15 a.m. - 6:30 p.m. (2nd day)

1st day: Levadia - Delphi (visit) followed by an afternoon at leisure. Overnight.

2nd day: Delphi, morning at leisure. Athens. Visitors spend a day of complete relaxation in Delphi.

Mon, Wed, Thurs from Apr 03 to Oct. 30

Also departures Saturdays Apr. 05, May 10, 17, 24 Jun. 07, 14, 28, July 12, 26, Aug. 08, 23, Sept. 06, 20, Oct. 04, 18.

From Nov. 05 '08 to Apr. 2 '09 every Wednesday.

Dep. 8:45 am - 6:30 p.m. (2nd day)

1st day: Drive to Delphi through Levadia and Arachova. Two hours at leisure. Depart for Kalambaka. Drive through Amphissa, Lamia and Trikala. Overnight.

2nd day: Morning visit to the breathtaking Meteora Monasteries. Originally reached by hinged ladders & windlasses, roads & stairs now provide access. The tallest spires exceed 1500 feet. Enjoy an incredible, panoramic view of the Plain of Thessaly. Afternoon Return Drive to Athens via Thermopylae.

DELPHI & METEORA

Sun, Tues. & Wed. from Apr 02 to Oct. 29, 08
Also departures Fridays Apr. 04, 18 May 09, 16, 23 Jun. 06, 13, 27, Jul. 11, 25, Aug. 08, 22, Sep. 05, 19, 26, Oct. 03, 17, 08.
Dep. 8:45 am - 6:30 p.m. (3rd day)

1st day: Drive to Delphi through Levadia and Arachnova. Upon arrival visit the archeological site and the Museum. Overnight in Delphi.
2nd day: Morning at leisure. Drive through the central Greece towns of Amphissa, Lamia and Trikala to arrive in Kalambaka. Overnight.
3rd day: In the morning visit the breathtaking Meteora and then start the drive back to Athens.

2nd day: Morning visit to archeological site and the museum at Olympia before driving Patras to Rion to Antirion and on to Delphi for dinner and overnight.
3rd day: Morning visit to the archeological sites and museum in Delphi. Afternoon drive back to Athens.

NORTHERN GREECE: (Footsteps of St. Paul)
Monday: May 19, Jun. 16, Sept. 08, 22, Oct. 06.
Depart Athens in the early morning.

1st day: Transfer from your Athens hotel to the airport for your morning flight to Thessaloniki. On arrival transfer to your hotel. Afternoon visit to the Museum with the famous "Vergina Treasures"; followed by a sightseeing tour of the city. Dinner and overnight.
2nd day: Morning drive to Pella. Alexander the Great's capital. (visit). Continue to Vergina to visit the tomb of King Philip (Alexander's father). Then on to Lefkadia where you visit the excavations. Return to Thessaloniki via Veria. Dinner and overnight.
3rd day: Start the return drive to Athens, through the Tempi Valley, Larissa, Lamia, Thermopylae.

1st day: Drive to the Corinth Canal (brief rest stop). Continue to Epidaurus visit the archeological site and the Theatre. Short stop in Nauplia and on to Mycenae for a visit to the archeological site before driving on to Olympia for dinner and overnight.
2nd day: Morning visit to archeological site and museum at Olympia before driving via Patras to Rion - Antirion and on to Delphi for dinner and overnight.
3rd day: Morning visit to the archeological sites and Museum in Delphi. Then drive through Amphissa, Lamia and Trikala to Kalambaka for dinner and overnight.
4th day: Morning visit to the breathtaking Meteora Monasteries. Afternoon drive back to Athens via Thermopylae (visit) and Kamena Vourla.

NORTHERN GREECE

Country of Alexander The Great and Footsteps of St. Paul
Saturday: May 17, Jun. 14, Sep. 06, 20, Oct. 04, 08.
8:15 am - 6:30 pm (5th day)

1st day: Drive to Delphi through Levadia and Arachova. Upon arrival visit the Museum and the archeological site. Rest of the day at leisure.
2nd day: Drive through the towns of Amphissa, Lamia and Trikala to Kalambaka. Then visit the breathtaking Meteora. Dinner and overnight in Kalambaka.
3rd day: Drive through Trikala and Larissa to the famous, sacred Macedonian town of Dion (visit). Then continue to Thessaloniki to visit the Museum with the famous "Vergina Treasures". Followed by a sightseeing tour of the city. Dinner and overnight.
4th day: Morning drive to Pella, Alexander the Great's capital (visit). On to Vergina to visit the tomb of King Philip (Alexander's father), and the famous Vergina Treasures. Then on to Lefkadia to visit the excavations. Return to Thessaloniki via Veria.
5th day: Start the return drive to Athens, through the Tempi Valley, Larissa, Lamia, Thermopylae Kamena, Vourla, Athens.

GRAND TOUR OF GREECE

Classical/Alexander The Great and Footsteps of St. Paul

2nd day: Drive through the cities of Megalopolis and Tripolis on route to Olympia. Afternoon visit to the archeological site & museum. Dinner and overnight in Olympia.
3rd day: Morning drive via Patras to Rion - Antirion and on to Delphi. On arrival visit the archeological site. Balance of the day at leisure.
4th day: Morning visit to the museum in Delphi. Then drive through Amphissa, Lamia and Trikala to Kalambaka. Afternoon visit to the breathtaking Meteora Monasteries. Dinner & overnight.
5th day: Drive through Trikala and Larissa to the famous, sacred Macedonian town of Dion (visit). Then continue to Thessaloniki. Visit the Museum with the famous "Vergina Treasures", followed by a sightseeing tour of the city. Dinner & overnight.
